Polite Reminders

Just a few polite reminders:

- Please remember to remove your child's earrings on PE days. If you are planning to have your child's ears pierced, please get this done at the beginning of the summer holidays, as they will not be able to take them out for 6 weeks. Children cannot take part in some aspects of PE with earrings in and this impacts on their learning in the PE curriculum.
- Children's school shoes should be black 'proper' shoes and not trainers, eg Nike.
- Hairstyles – please ensure hairstyles are suitable for school, long hair is tied back and extreme hair styles/adornments are saved for the weekend!
- Dogs are not allowed on the school site (either on a lead or being carried).
- Please ensure that all scooters and bikes are dismounted before entering the school site.
- When attending a school event, please ensure that photos are for your own use and not uploaded on to social media as you do not have other parents' permission for this.
